The positivity, spirit, and joy that everyone brought to the gathering made the celebration even more special and memorable.

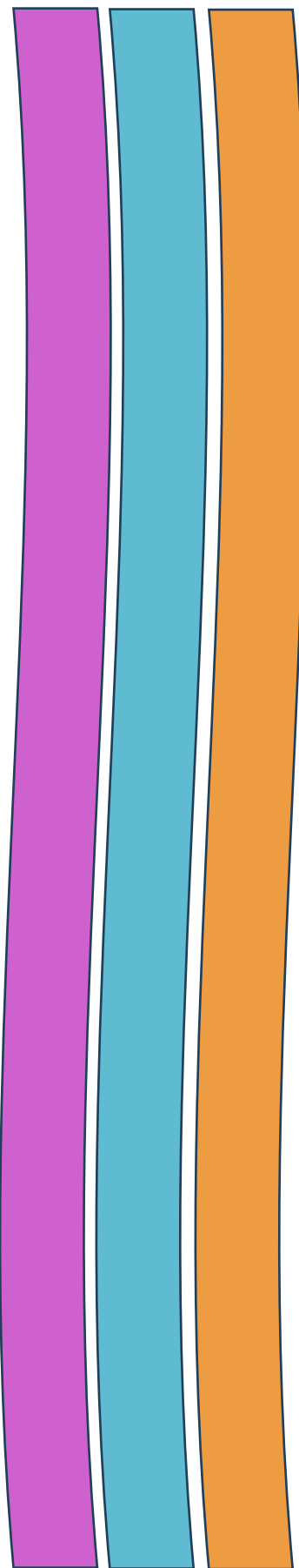
It was heart-warming to see such togetherness and shared happiness all around.

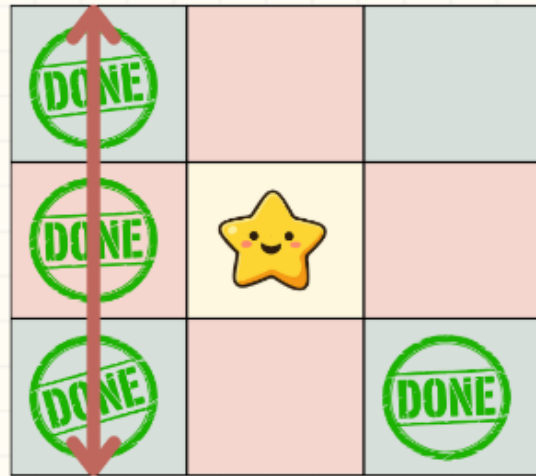

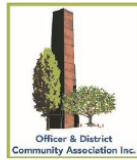
