Please come along to our 2026 Secondary Community Connections and Exploring Post School Options EXPO on Thursday, 30th April – 4.00 to 6.00pm.

This is an opportunity to

- Spend time **meeting other students and families** in the Secondary Department
- Learn about the **options available to students as they transition from school** (the year after they turn 18).
- Learn about **community supports available** (for student that are still at school) – including NDIS funded services.

The Expo will feature a range of services and supports that can help guide students into their next steps, including:

- Open Employment
- Supported Employment
- Apprenticeships / Traineeships
- Further Education & Training
- Microenterprises
- School Leaver Employment Support Programs
- Group Based Activities (previously day programs)
- Individualised Support (support workers)
- Volunteering
- Other (Support Coordination, alternative therapy options, holidays programs etc)
- NDIS

As we have students of varying ages that attend the Expo (from grade 6 to year 12), a strong focus has been on also inviting services that can offer some supports whilst your child is still at school (e.g. holiday programs, 1:1 support, therapy etc).

It is also a great opportunity for you to speak with providers to let them know what type of services / support your child may be looking for when they transition from school. This will give them an opportunity to help understand future needs in our local community.

Please come along to support this event (even if you have been before). It takes up a lot of valuable time from the service providers, and we want them to feel it is valuable to come each year!

The Expo is also open to students & families that attend other schools in our community and/or have graduated in previous years and are looking for other options.
